Throughout the indoor learning environments, materials are displayed to be inviting to children. Invitations set up on tables and shelving are displayed at the children's level so that they may be accessed independently and inspire and invite children's engagement. Books are also displayed throughout all interest centres.

General Comments

Children's current interests and learning are evident in documentation posted. Through learning stories, and photos, educators demonstrate the ways they support and celebrate children's interests and achievements.

Educators were observed to be engaged with children at their level. In particular during lunch time, educators sat along side children, engaging in authentic and meaningful back and forth conversation as the children enjoyed their lunch.

Discussed with administrator ensuring that monthly fire drills are completed at a variety of times throughout the day rather than the same predictable time.
