### General Comments

Renewal Inspection completed today.

Evidence of a purposefully planned and documented program observed in all play areas. Children's current interests are reflected in the props and materials available. Documentation of children's learning observed in the forms of interest webs, photos, artwork, learning stories, and are displayed thoughtfully at the children's level. Providing opportunities for children to revisit their work, see photos of themselves and their families in the environment can spark conversations, new learning and new interests.

Educators were observed to engage with children throughout all times of the day. Engaging in play, during transitions, singing songs, reading books, playing games. Inspector observed an educator during diaper changing engaged with a child in back and forth conversation. The educator listened attentively to the child, asked questions, and repeated back to the child what she had said. It was a great way to value the child, build language, and engage one on one during a routine part of the day.

General Comments

Recommendation to post contact information for operator/administrator and licensing staff in upstairs preschool room.

Attendance records- Ensure all children are signed in on arrival and out on departure. When children are absent, the reason code must be added.
