A monitoring inspection was completed today. Educators and children were observed throughout the morning during indoor play, outdoor play, transitions and meal times.

Indoor environments are purposefully planned with materials that reflect children's current interests and learning. Documentation in the form of learning stories are thoughtfully displayed at the children's level providing opportunities for them to revisit their learning. Photos of children displayed in frames creates a welcoming environment and a sense of belonging.

Outdoors, children played in the outdoor play area, at the skate park and went for walks. A variety of materials are available for use in the outdoor play area, including creative materials, bubbles, trucks, mud kitchen and accessories.

Educators were observed engaging with children in play. During snack and lunch, educators sat alongside
