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General Comments Renewal Inspection: A renewal inspection was conducted for both the infant and preschool programs during the morning and afternoon. The infants and preschool children were observed to participate in a variety of activities both indoors and outdoors. Indoors, the children were observed during snack time, lunch, and nap time. Outdoors, the children were observed engaging in sensory play, listening to music, coloring, exploring the property, going for walks, and playing with their educators. The classrooms were set up with a wide range of open-ended materials for the children to engage in play. Invitations to play were arranged to welcome the children upon returning from outdoor play. The materials were stored on low, open shelves, making them easily accessible to the children and supporting independent choice and exploration. The documentation was current and reflective of the children's past play experiences. Photos of the children and samples of their artwork were displayed throughout the rooms. The following records were reviewed: incident logs, fire drill records, daily attendance records, infant, toddler daily sheets, professional learning hours, a sample of children's files, and all staff files. Handwashing and diaper-changing practices were also observed during the inspection. Sixteen staff members require additional professional learning hours and will complete their remaining hours by August 31, 2026. The QAM will follow up on the next monitoring inspection. The facility is recommended for licensing.
