Incident logs are confidential to each child and are related to the health, security, and well-being of the children receiving services at your facility. Therefore, as discussed, continued behavioral issues between children must be documented in a way that shows the child's name, the date and time that the incident occured, what happened and include the parent(s) signature.

Comments: There were children in the entry way unsupervised and engaging in innapropriate behaviour. Licensing staff spoke to one of the educators and advised them of the behaviours. Children should not be unsupervised in a public building at any time and the children should only go to the washroom one at at time.				
General Comments				
The daily routine that is posted does not reflect what the children are actually doing at the facility. The daily activities of a licensed facility must be purposefully planned in advance and documented responding to the capabilities, needs and interests of the children. There was no pre-planned activities for this age-group. As discussed with one of the educators, the pre-planned program can be demonstrated in such ways as a weekly				

program or daily activity sheets. Programming needs to be implemented, dated and kept on file for each day, week, or month up until the next renewal inspection so that it can be verified by licensing staff.

Currently, there are no learning centres set up for this facility. There is a disorganized, incomplete materials stored in the closets of the gym and centres were not set up at the time of licensing staff's visit. A wide range of opportunities must be offered to school-age children. The following allows school age children to explore new interests and relationships.

-team sports / gross motor play

- -dramatic play
- -art and creative area
- -music
- -games
- -block and construction area

-a quiet and reading area
