Nancy Glendenning and Jennifer Godin conducted a follow-up visit. Upon arrival there were 8 chiildrren in attendance playing outside. Upon entering the facility there were 5 centres set up for the children. Moving forward, the centres must be set up prior to the children's arrival and please continue adding resources to the learning centres.

It is recommended that the gym be seperated into two sections leaving the learning centres at one end and gross motor play at the other so that it doesn't interfere with the children's play. The Quality Assurance Monitor will continue to monitor the environment and support the facility to ensure compliance with this regulation.

There was a broken table being used in one of the centres. It was moved at the time of visit.

The first aid kit is now complete. Please ensure that it continues to be maintained and is brought with the educators on all excursions off site and when the children are outside.
