Comments: Documentary evidence of the children's learning must be made evident for each child attending your facility.

Comments: Operator could not find fire drill records. Please ensure fire drills are conducted at various times of the day and once a month using different exits.

Comments: Fire Drills must be completed monthly.

Comments: The indoor play areas of a facility must have organized and flexible learning centres that are well-defined, and accommodate and encourage a variety of activities to support appropriate curriculum implementation. The environment should minimally include but are not limited to the following: a book / reading area, an art area, a block construction area, a science/math area, a music /movement area. Currently, with the pandemic it is understood that some materials will not be able to be included in the area but substitutions or provisions can be made to ensure that there are enough learning centres set up for each classroom and age group.

Comments: Operator stated that educator who is in charge of the maintenance checklist of outdoor play space is not working today and could not find the documentation. However, she stated that it is being completed.			

General Comments

The facility is clean and educators are following proper handwashing protocols. Covid-19 Guidelines are being followed.

Please ensure that Fire drill and different evacuation routes are conducted monthly.

The outdoor inspection lists for the last year will be verified upon next visit. Please ensure that checklists are completed and maintained. They must include the review and repair dates, the action required and action taken and the name of the staff who conducted the review.

Cleaning lists are apparent however the operator and I discussed how a cleaning schedule and disinfectant schedule must be in place with clear accountabilities assigned to a specific staff. Please include all areas and what needs to be cleaned daily or after each use. For example, each classroom, bathroom, outdoor play areas, gym, etc...Please specify what needs to be cleaned, what to use to clean it and how to clean it.

There was a lot of crying happening during nap time. I opened the door and an educator stated that they were having difficulty with nap time as a child came in late to the facility. Please be advised that children who do not nap after a period of time should be allowed to get up and play quietly. Also, the 2's nap area is quite dark so there should be some form of light put in there to avoid possible safety issues.

Please see comments throughout inspection regarding a purposefully planned program and setting up an educational environment for children.
