General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the 3- and 4-year-old children were upstairs playing in the gym while the younger classes were napping. The children were seen playing with basketballs, plasma cars and hula hoops. Once quiet time was over, the children in the gym cleaned up then got in line to return to their classroom. Hand washing was observed before they entered their class.

As the younger children woke up from nap time, diaper changes and hand washing procedures were observed. In one room the children were enjoying a pumpkin activity with one of the Educators. All the children were given a spoon and helped scoop the seeds out into a large bowl. In another room children were seen playing with wooden puzzles, engaged in a fall leaf craft, coloring and reading stories. After having some free play, all classes washed their hands for afternoon snack. Tables were sanitized and floors were swept after snack time was over. After snack the children packed up their belongings and went outside to play.

The classrooms are clean and organized. The walls have a variety of learning stories, artwork, family pictures and documentation of learning and pre-planned activities. The Educators were engaged with the children and attentive to their needs, wiping their nose when needed and eating snack at the tables with the children during afternoon snack. Allergies are posted and cubbies are labelled and tidy. An Educator was observed snapping their fingers at a child during the transition from the gym back to the classroom. Please ensure that positive behavior guidance such as gentle reminders or using the child's name to get their attention is being used at all times.
