Comments: Licensing staff observed unsupervised children in the classroom and in the common area while staff rotated throughout the different areas.							
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General Comments

When licensing staff arrived, educators and children were enjoying outdoor time. Licensing staff relayed the importance of having sufficient materials accessible to the children both indoors and outdoors. Please refer to Appendix 24 in the Operators Manual for what minimally needs to be included as well as lists of suggestions. It is important to prepare the indoor play areas to ensure a smooth running program.

Licensing staff observed children being unsupervised in the classroom and common area while a staff was attending to a child's needs in the washroom. It was also noted that children were frequently wandering back and forth through the common area unattended and remaining in the entrance way with no supervision. Please refer to Section 8.1.5 of the Operators Manual.
