Comments: While inspecting the outdoor play environment, licensing staff noted the following safety hazards:  -a shelf in the treehouse has protruding screws and staples. Please remove these screws to ensure the safety of the children.  -the sand pit on the left side of the outdoor play environment has a sandpit that is uncovered. Please cover the sandpit so the wildlife and animals in the area do not defecate in the sandpit.  -also, to the left of the outdoor play environment, the wooden mud kitchen needs to be cleaned off as it is covered in spider webs.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	32(1)(a)	Jul 11, 2025	
Comments: Licensing staff observed some materials in the indoor play environment; however, more materials are needed for the children. Some materials to be added are age-appropriate books, coloured paper, additional craft supplies such as glitter, additional glue, scissors, paper and dramatic play materials.  Licensing staff observed a bin with plastic food items but there wasn't a play kitchen to use the plastic food items. Also observed in the indoor play environment was a large wooden doll playhouse but no accessories for the playhouse. Please add dolls, doll furniture and doll clothing.			

General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the license renewal inspection. When licensing staff arrived, the children were engaging in free play activities before having their afternoon snack.</p> <p>After snack, the children went outside to engage in water play before coming back inside. Once back inside, the children divided up into smaller groups. One group played in the classroom while another group played in the gym.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed the educators positively interact with the children by using gentle verbal reminders of</p>

voice levels and prompting the children to use their words with their friends when they are upset with them.

Staff and children's files were complete with the required documentation and information.

Child-to-staff ratios were more than the regulation required throughout the licensing inspection.

There was documentation of the children's learning posted on the walls/doors for the children to revisit the learning experiences.
