General Comments

Licensing staff conducted a follow-up licensing inspection visit on July 30th, 2021. While conducting the follow-up inspection, licensing staff noted that compliance orders from the previous inspection were not corrected.

The educator in charge on the day of the follow-up inspection visit relayed to licensing staff that the shade for the infant play space was ordered but has not yet come in.

The educator in charge also relayed to licensing staff that the educators that are required to renew their First Aid/CPR certification are scheduled to do this in mid-August.

While conducting the follow-up licensing inspection, licensing staff noted that the fire extinguisher that was located at the back door is still not secured to the wall. Please ensure this is secured to the wall in order to maintain the children's safety.

The educator in charge on the day of the follow-up inspection relayed to licensing staff that a container of age appropriate play materials for the school-aged children is kept in the office and when the school-aged children go outside the educator brings this container of play materials outside with them.
