Comments: The centre is not clean, unorganized and cluttered.  All rooms must be deep cleaned, floors swept and washed.  All carpets must be vacuumed and washed as per Public Health guidelines.  All costumes and plush toys must be washed as per Public Health guidelines.  All interlocking mats are heavily soiled and must be discarded or replaced. It was evident that the floors were not being swept under those interlocking mats.  The nap rooms must be cleaned, decluttered and organized.  All shelving and toys must be cleaned and disinfected.  All walls have stains, marks and chips; therefore, the walls need to be painted.  There is a very strong smell of dirty diapers in the Centre and therefore, proper garbage cans are needed to ensure the smell is kept locked inside the garbage or a better system of disposing dirty diapers is required.  There is a very strong sour smell in the infant area. I believe this may be coming from the bathroom.
