General Comments

Name of operator

Two staff were observed engaged in learning with the children. One was sitting with her group, reading them a book, and talking about emotions. The other was sitting in a circle with the children and talking about shapes and colors. One staff was also observed using proper redirection techniques when children were stepping on toys, so the staff replaced the toy with wooden blocks so the children could continue to step up and down on the blocks.

One child vomited on the carpet and the staff cleaned it with the disinfectant spray. In a case like this, the carpet should have been removed and steamed cleaned to ensure it's properly to avoid contamination.

The storage bin in the outside playground is too large and the children cannot take toys out. Today one child shut the lid on the head and hand of another child. The children were trying to access toys and there was no help from the staff. The inspector advised staff that the bin was too large, and the children needed help to take the items out. The staff laughed and rolled her eyes at the inspector. The bin must be replaced with something smaller, or toys may be put into smaller bins and taking out by staff each morning. The large bin also needs to be relocated so children cannot shut the lid and injure another child.

I would recommend more Legos, different size Legos, as the children were asking for Lego today and there was only one bin being used by another group.

The table in the 2-year-old room was fixed. It's taller and the clairs are still low to the ground and so the table and chairs shappropriate table and chair.	•
