If educators are having a difficult time ensuring the children's belongings are properly hung up in the back of the room, it is recommended that the hooks and shelving unit with their baskets be moved to the entrance of the nap room wall inside the playroom.

General Comments

Children from Baby Boulevard were already outside playing when Quality Assurance Monitor arrived for today's follow up inspection. Children were schedule to come in at a certain time, but educator followed the children's lead and stayed outside longer because children were having fun dancing to the music that one of the preschool educator's brought out with them.

General Comments

While outside, educators were observed singing and dancing with children.

All educators were able to provide evidence of daily planning at time of follow up inspection.

All children were observed to be in their assigned rooms at time of follow-up inspection. Only time children were combined with a different room was during a one-hour period for programming purposes.

Screws in infant room that were sticking out from the wall have been removed.

Both baby gates in Lullaby Land and Baby Boulevard have been replaced and are now able to be properly opened.

Observed children's water bottles being taken outside with them.

All infant bottles observed in fridge had their own cover.

Infant gate is now able to be properly closed and latched.

Area around shade structure in preschool outside play space remains a little icy, staff are aware and are working towards rectifying the situation. Administrator informed Quality Assurance Monitor that more salt will be added along with additional supervision measures to ensure children's safety.

Quiet time was observed to be chaotic in the Silly Street classroom, with children screaming and running around the room while others were sleeping. It is recommended that the quiet time routine be revised for this room.

A reminder that opens ended play materials and equipment in sufficient quantity and variety for the size of the group and representative of each of the following categories is present for each classroom, for example:

- art materials including loose parts
- · blocks and accessories
- language and literacy
- dramatic play
- · music and movement
- large muscle (gross motor)
- manipulative and fine motor
- · sand and water pla
- puzzles and games
- materials that support mathematical learning
- materials that support learning in science and technology
