General Comments

Infant educators were getting children ready to go play outside when I arrived for today's monitoring inspection. Educators in Lullaby Lane were observed washing their hands in between diaper changes. One educator was observed changing diapers while the second educator in the room was observed getting the children ready in the stroller.

Preschool children were getting ready to head outside to play when I arrived. They were excited to get outside to play before it starts raining.

General Comments

Educators on the infant side of the facility were able to provide documentation of proof of daily planning at time inspection.

All educators were observed interacting with children at time of visit.

Observed preschool educators in Kindergarten Crossing room discussing children's interests and programming ideas for next while during quiet time.

Fire drills are being carried out on a monthly basis.

When educator in Lullaby Lane was asked why the children's bags weren't properly stored on children's hooks, they stated that they didn't have time to do it this morning. It is evident from today's monitoring visit, and past inspections, that educators in Lullaby Lane are having a difficult time ensuring that children's belongings are properly hung up in the back of the nap room; therefore, to avoid future non-compliances, it is recommended that the hooks and shelving unit with children's baskets be moved to the entrance of the nap room wall or on the wall inside the playroom near the entrance.

Quiet time routine in Silly Street classroom has been revised. Children were observed quietly playing while others were sleeping.

A reminder that educators have until August 31st, 2024, to complete their required amount of Professional Learning Hours as outlined in the Designation Handbook.
