<p>Renewal Inspection performed. Approved allocated space has changed since last inspection - for Covid requirements. The room has been divided to keep group sizes under 15 child spaces.</p> <p>*Covid-19 recovery phase guidelines are being followed - signage posted and washing hands posters observed. Children observed washing hands. A daily log is kept for each self contained group and temperature checked in AM and mid-day. It is recommended upon arrival, that parents are asked if they did the morning screening and their children meet all of the criteria of wellness. Parents have signed Appendix E and this is stored and available upon request. When doing a temperature check with children under 12 years, using a non contact thermometer by the Educator is not permitted. Options include Armpit or ear thermometer. Please commence documenting for those children under 12 years.</p> <p>*educators are cleaning and this is being documented.</p> <p>*All administrative files were reviewed and files are organized and complete.</p> <p>*Staff were observed using appropriate child guidance practices. Lots of interaction observed and children seem to be involved and having fun. All children were observed in outdoor play activities.</p>

General Comments

\*Operator has a few compliances to address in the afterschool outdoor play area. After discussion with the Administrator, she indicated the operator has pea gravel on order. This is required around the Dome climbing structure and teter totter.  
\* Fun age appropriate educational programming observed - children learning about Sharks during my visit which lead to other activities.
