Comments: While licensing staff was conducting the license renewal inspection, it was noted that a light in one of the bathrooms was not working. The Acting Director relayed to licensing staff that the bulb was replaced however, the light still wouldn't work. The Acting Director added that they have been in touch with an electrician to come and look at the light.

Comments: When Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the license renewal inspection, she noted that one of the doors had a broken door knob. This could pose as a safety hazard and will need to be repaired.			

### General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on September 2nd, 2021 to conduct the license renewal inspection.

When licensing staff arrived at the centre, the children were still arriving for the day. The educators were seen engaging with the children at the children's level. Licensing staff also noted that only positive child guidance techniques were used by the educators during the inspection visit.

Licensing staff also noted that one group of children were drawing with markers and paper while another group of children were building with lego. Later, on in the morning, the group that was building with lego began to play a game similar to hockey but without sticks. The children built a puck using lego. The children also built goal posts out of lego! When licensing staff approached one of the educators in the room, the educator relayed to licensing staff that the children created the hockey-like game all on their own!! This is fantastic example of encouraging the children to be independent as well as creative. Well done!!

Licensing staff also noted that the children's files, as well as, the staff files were complete and very organized.

While licensing staff was conducting the license renewal inspection, it was noted that the afterschool children from one license is combined with the children of the second license located on the upper level of the building. The reason for combining the children is to maintain the child-to-staff ratio while the children arrive first thing in the morning. At approximately 8:00am, the afterschool children from one license move downstairs to their

assigned space. The Acting Director relayed to the licensing staff that combining children from both licenses was only happening during the summer time and not throughout the school year.

The children from one license are not permitted to combine with children from a second license. Please ensure that the children enrolled in one license do not combine, at any time during operating hours, with with any other children from a secondary license.
