General Comments
<p>Annual Inspection performed.</p> <p>Upon arrival only 3 young school age children on site. All children arrived by 3:35 pm and proceeded with washing hands and sitting down to eat snack. Educators were observed sitting and eating with the first group of children, having fun conversation.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed children building robots and using magnetic blocks to create interesting buildings. Appropriate child guidance was observed. Educators show a genuine interest in the children by asking them questions. Lots of positive conversation observed also.</p> <p>Administrative records were reviewed, attendance is tracked, child files are neatly organized, staff records are neatly organized and assessable, including financial records (see comment above), fire drills are practiced, incident reports are being completed and signed off by parents. First aid checklist is also completed monthly. All records are available and stored organized.</p> <p>Licensing staff has visited this centre on a number of occasions, and it was observed during this visit that the walls were recently painted - a nice neutral color. The Administrator advised that the walls are bare and that the plan is to install the parent board, handwashing signs, and children's names put up in the cubby area this weekend. This is always in place during previous visits.</p> <p>Please update my telephone number when you install your parent board - 506-429-2028</p> <p>All children were observed getting ready for outdoor play during the inspection visit. The outdoor play space is snow covered, however during recent visits pea gravel is in place for the climbing structure. Educators provided lots of notice between activities.</p>
