monitoring inspection completed.

Administrative records were reviewed and child attendance is tracked daily in the early AM and also in PM. Fire drill was performed and outdoor checklist was completed during licensing staff visit. Incidents are recorded, though there have been none recently. Licensing staff also reviewed the staff file for updated FA certificates. The operator arrived and licensing staff was given a paper copy of the Renewal application for the FT centre. Children were observed eating lunch upon arrival, then moved into quiet activities. Educators set up different stations - reading area, puzzles, lego, other games. All children and educators were observed performing a fire drill during the inspection visit. The children walked to the outdoor play space and lined up against the fence for rollcall. Educators filled water bottles during lunch so children would have access to water when outdoors. All

children were observed playing cooperatively with their friends.

The second group of afterschoolers arrived and then the group proceeded to go outside. It is a beautiful sunny and warm day. Parents have been reminded as it is their responsibility to send sunblock to the centre labeled with their child's name as it cannot be shared between children. The weather is getting warmer and it is important that children have some to protect them from the sunrays.
