General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were all seated having lunch. As the children finished eating, they chose a book and read until the rest of the group had finished lunch. Tables were cleaned, floors were swept, and activities were set up. An Educator provided the children turns to choose their activity Children were observed playing LEGO, reading, making their own ornaments and using the play kitchen. At the tables, painting was set up with a variety of utensils to paint with such as toothbrushes, rollers and paint brushes. An Educator was heard praising the children for their creativity.

Today is "Festive Friday" at the Centre. Children and Educators were dressed in festive pajamas and Santa hats. The classroom has been decorated for the holidays. A decorated Christmas tree and festive artwork is displayed throughout the classroom. The shelves and bins have been organized since the last visit. The room is clean and organized. An Educator mentioned that they've gone through the materials in the classroom and removed what the children no longer have an interest in.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's visit. The children appear to be comfortable with the routine and Educators. The children freely explored different areas of the classroom, and all transitions were smooth. The posting board has been updated since the last Monitoring Inspection. Current Quality Assurance Monitor and Inspector contact information is posted as well as allergies in the classroom. It is recommended that all first aid kits are sorted, and any expired materials are replaced.
