General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival to conduct the renewal inspection, children had just finished morning snack and were preparing to go outdoors.

The indoor space was welcoming, bright and organized. Play material such as board games, puzzles, books, Lego, and a fuse ball table were in good condition and easily accessible. Personal belongings were organized on hooks with the children's names. Before going outdoors, the children were observed changing their footwear and lining up. To capture the children's attention, an Educator was heard saying " if you can hear me touch your head, if you can hear me touch your nose". Water bottles were filled up and placed in a basket to be taken outdoors as well as the first aid backpack and daily attendance form.

The outdoor space was fully fenced, and large shade sails were in place. Play material such as a dome play climber, a wooden seesaw, soccer balls, an outdoor chalk wall with chalk, and building blocks were in good condition. The children's outdoor activities aligned with the planned weekly theme. Children were observed playing washer toss, ring toss, and corn hole for carnival week. Children had decorated envelopes to place winning tickets in for an end of week carnival prize day. Educators were engaged with the children and were observed participating in the activities and offering positive words of encouragement.

Later in the morning before coming indoors, a gentle clean up reminder was heard. Once play material was cleaned up, the children were observed lining up inside the fence to come indoors. A headcount was observed as the children were leaving the fence and also before entering the facility. Once indoors, personal belongings were hung up and proper hand washing was observed before the children sat together to eat lunch.

During inspection, staff and child files were verified and all required licensing documentation was present. Monthly fire drills and outdoor maintenance checks are being completed and logged. Cleaning products are being stored in a locked closet and allergy information was visibly posted on the posting board.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal pending fire inspection.
