The operator confirms that when they receive prescribed medication, that the medication is also labelled with the doctor's name, instructions for use, and the time period for use.

The operator has confirmed that parents must notify them of their child's absence and must indicate if the absence is due to illness or other reasons. The operator confirmed that if a child becomes ill while they are at the facility that they are separated from the other children to be provided with care until someone is able to pick up the child, within one hour of notification of illness. The operator validated that children are provided with medical assistance is required and that the management of potential illness forms are completed as required. The operator confirmed that the parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness.

The operator validated that parent provide written or oral permission to give acetaminophen. The operator confirmed that when parents provide oral permission to give acetaminophen, a written confirmation is given when they pick up their child. The operator has confirmed that the administration of medication records are kept for each child as indicated in regulation 24(3).

The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that all toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies were locked and made inaccessible to the children during the inspection.
