Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the Medicare number is missing in 2 of the 7 child files verified. During the inspection, the parent added the Medicare numbers to the child profile. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that a staff member's file is missing a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate (administrator and educators only). During the inspection, the operator placed a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate (administrator and educators only) in the staff member's file. Deficiency is now compliant.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Sep 05, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that dust has accumulated on 3 window sills and on the top of some shelves. The operator must dust these surfaces and ensure that surfaces used by children are cleaned and sanitized daily.

Upon arrival to the facility, the inspector was informed by the operator that the facility was opened but that no children were in attendance.

The inspector did not observe the following items:

- Opportunities to problem solve
- Opportunities to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships
