Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the window sills and shelf had been dusted. Deficiency is now compliant.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Nov 09, 2023	Nov 09, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed two piles of dog feces in the outdoor play area. During the inspection, the operator cleaned and disposed of the dog feces. The inspector also observed broken toys such as a hockey net, a shovel, a frisbee and a bucket. To encourage the children to be active and involved in activities, the operator must regularly inspect all outdoor play area materials to ensure they are safe and functional. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Nov 13, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 2 out of 4 water bottles are not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that water bottles are labelled with the child's name in order to prevent and control the spread of communicable diseases and illness.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Nov 13, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 2 out of 3 lunchboxes are not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that all food brought from home is labeled with the child's name.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed indoor free play, snack time and outdoor free play.</p> <p>The inspector also observed the educator reading a book to the children and helping the children build a castle with building blocks.</p>
