Documentation posted in the four-year-old included documenting children's photo taking in A world in the eyes of a child poster with children's photos. Two charts were posted with how many letters are in each child's name

and their favorite ways to eat an apple. The preschool room signs in each morning at the door on a white board allowing children to practice their names and learn to recognize the names of their friends. I encouraged educators to provide writing utensils and blank paper accessible to children throughout the day so children can independently choose these items, building their writing identities.

The rooms are clean and organized with lots of natural light.

The junior infants were offered a tunnel within the room today that the children enjoyed climbing through, retrieving balls and meeting their friends. The senior infants were singing songs from a Talk with Me session this morning before lunchtime. You can tell children are used to the routine as they cleaned up after leaving the mat and then headed to the table for lunch.

The preschoolers were joining different invitations throughout the room after lunch as the educators responded to children, as needed. In each room, the educators gave children choice and asked questions requesting consent for more food, if they were done, did they need help, or if they wanted to join in play.
