General Comments							
When I arrived at the ELC home, the children were napping or having a quiet rest. When they got up, they washed their hands, had a snack, and then had time for free play. The children appeared to enjoy their free play and many played with blocks and super hero action figures. They were creative and built some interesting things with the blocks. They were planning to go outside as I was leaving.							

I looked at the staff files, child files, and administrative files while I was there. The staff files have all necessary information in them, and all required checks are up to date. The child files also contain all necessary information. They are all well organized. Fire drills are completed every month and the first aid kit and outdoor area are checked each month. Attendance records are kept up to date and daily information sheets were done regularly when they were required. All necessary postings are displayed as well.

I noted in particular the positive child guidance shown by the operator. She was very engaged with the children, she was quick to meet the children's needs, and she encouraged independence while still being there to help when needed. She demonstrated positive reinforcement, gentle reminders, encouragement, and active listening. She took the time to answer children's questions and explained things well to them. She was teaching them emotional regulation, and used distraction and redirection when necessary. She comforted children when they needed it, and was patient, kind, and caring with the children.

Everything appeared to go well on the day of my visit.
