General Comments

Upon arrival for the renewal inspection, children were observed playing indoors in the designated play area. They were engaged with magnetic blocks on the carpet. The operator then transitioned the children to the table for an art activity, offering them the choice to draw a Christmas tree or create their own drawings. She sat with the children and drew alongside them on a large sheet of paper, providing support and encouragement throughout the activity.

When it was time to clean up, the operator made it into a game, motivating the children to tidy up quickly and cooperatively. Following this, she prepared the group to go outside, assisting them as needed while promoting independence.

Outdoors, the children played in a large open field. Together with the operator, they helped rebuild a Little Tikes structure, using toy tools and demonstrating a strong interest in building and construction activities. Afterwards, the group ventured into the wooded area, collecting bowls to fill with apples from a nearby tree to "feed the deer." They continued their exploration with a nature walk that led to a small pond, where the children engaged in supervised water play. Children threw apples and rocks in the pond, and jumped in puddles.

At lunchtime, the group returned to the home. The children removed their outdoor wear and washed their hands before sitting at the table. The operator heated their lunches, reminded them to wait until the food had cooled, and taught them how to check the temperature safely by blowing on their food.

After lunch, the children settled onto their individual cots and cribs with their own blankets and pillows from home. While the children rested, the operator cleaned and organized the space.

Child and staff files were reviewed and verified. Only positive child guidance strategies were observed throughout the visit. Documentation of autumn learning stories was displayed, highlighting recent activities and learning experiences.

Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
