Comments: By reviewing the staff and the children's attendance records for the week of June 6th - June 10th 2022, it is evident that one staff was left alone to supervise 2 infants and 4 preschoolers. As infants are not permitted to be part of a mixed age group, Operator must ensure that the infants and the preschoolers have an adequate number of staff to maintain ratio for each group.

One side of the room was approved for 6 preschool children and the other side closest to the immediate exit was approved for 3 infants. It was observed during the inspection that the infants were located on the preschool side and the preschool and school aged children were on the infant side. As infants are not permitted to be moved from spaces that are approved for them, the Operator must return the infants to their side and the preschool children to their side.
