Comments: Adequate protective surfacing was added around the Little Tikes play structure. A discussion was had with the Educator, who indicates that the Little Tikes will be removed from the outdoor play area and that the children are not currently using this equipment. If it is decided that children will use the Little Tikes, Operator must ensure that pea gravel continues to be raked to ensure proper protective surfacing. Inspector also recommends that if children are no longer using the Little Tikes, that ribbon be added around the equipment to indicate that it is currently not in use.
