Comments: The Renewal application was received and the Licensing Inspector determined that many educators have not completed any or few PL training hours for this licensing year. All staff working with children and who have their ECE or other recognized training must complete up to 10 hours of PL training. This is a requirement for Designation. Licensing staff in discussion with the Operator documented the staff that must complete PL hours prior to the expiry of the current license which is December 31st, Licensing staff recommended to the Operator to contact the District team and also provided the names of the consultants. They would be able to assist with providing virtual training sessions, book study ideas. There is also an indigenous story telling session on Oct 17 at the Hanwell Community Centre. The deadline is today to register.

It was observed in one of the classrooms that lunch bags were left unzipped from morning snack. Always replenish toilet paper when empty. The toilet paper was replenished during the visit.					

## **General Comments**

Upon arrival all children and educators were indoors. Many were in the process of toileting and putting on outdoor shoes and jackets for outdoor play activities. The young 2's were excited to tell me they were going outside to play. All children were observed in outdoor play.

The 3- and 4-year-old group were involved in a Thanksgiving painting activity and then were observed getting ready for outside play.

The Licensing inspector observed educators cleaning and sanitizing the tables after the painting activity. Cleaning schedules are evident in the bathrooms. The toilet paper roll was replenished in one of the bathrooms. The older preschoolers are very interested in bugs, dinosaurs and trucks. The licensing inspector observed many children playing with ride on trucks outdoors. Other children played in small groups and were observed playing with balls, playing house, sliding, shoveling pea gravel. Licensing staff observed the mud kitchen is lacking implements and would be great playspace for children to enjoy with the addition of implements to this area.

It was recommended the tables in the 2 and 3 classrooms be lowered to accommodate the needs of this age group especially while eating their snacks and lunches.

This operator offers an inclusive program to children in attendance.

Children that nap were observed waking, having diapers changed if application or assisted with toileting.
