General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct a follow-up license renewal inspection.</p> <p>The infant room now has some mark-making materials for the infants to explore. Licensing staff observed crayons and stampers were added to a bin that are accessible to the children. When speaking with the educator in charge, licensing staff mentioned that paper, such as white paper and construction paper, should also be added to the shelf along with additional mark-making supplies, such as chalk and pencil crayons.</p> <p>While observing in the 2-year-old classroom, licensing staff noted that the flaking paint has been sanded and repainted. Also, in the infant room the splash panel has been repaired.</p> <p>The outdoor play environment has one surface, and, in the Spring, a second play surface will need to be added. The Quality Assurance Monitor will come back to verify that a second surface has been added once the snow melts. A couple of options for surfacing are wood chips, mulch, sand or a wooden stage just to name a few.</p> <p>Licensing staff is recommending the facility for their license renewal.</p>
