General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, all classes were observed playing outside in the fenced in playground. Families were greeted as they arrived for morning drop off. Sunscreen and water bottles were brought outside, and Educators were heard announcing water breaks. One class was observed bringing their lunch boxes to a shaded area in the grass to have a picnic for morning snack. As the children finished eating, one Educator played parachute games while the other Educator created an obstacle course.

The transition from the outdoor playground to inside was smooth. Walking ropes were used by the older preschool age children, and wagons were used for the infants to ensure their safety as they walked through the parking lot. Head counts were observed during this time. Once inside the facility, the Educators were observed taking small groups of children to use the washroom and wash hands before having morning snack. Activities were prepared and ready as the children finished eating morning snack. In one classroom, large bins were set up. In one bin, ferns, flowers, spoons, bowls and scissors were set up, while another had playdoh, rolling pins, wooden discs and rocks.

A list of allergies is posted as you enter the facility. Fire drills were also posted and are up to date. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children, offering hugs, and speaking with the children at their level. Educators were observed helping friends during a small disagreement. Positive words of encouragement were heard, and problem-solving skills were used.
