Comments: During the inspection, the inspector saw that the indoor play materials such as art supplies, blocks, books and dramatic play items were not easily accessible to the children. A discussion was had regarding having these objects accessible to them. Inspector recommends that the operator get in touch with their Quality Assurance Monitor regarding this.

Comments: A bottle of mouth wash was found under the bathroom sink, which was not locked. This was placed in a locked closet immediately. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: Inspector saw an infant drinking out of a bottle while unsupervised. A discussion was had with the operator regarding this. Deficiency is now compliant.

A discussion was had with the operator regarding updating the Diaper Changing Procedures form that is posted. Inspector recommended that the Diaper Changing Procedures be reviewed and updated. During the inspection, operator was observed being attentive to the children. Operator was communicating with the children by getting down to their level. Inspector observed songs being sung and books being read to the children.
