31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children. Comments: Stagnant water was found in the tires in the outdoor play area. A discussion was had with the operator regarding draining these.	31(3)	May 13, 2022	
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility, Comments: During the inspection, the inspector saw that the indoor play materials such as art supplies, blocks, books and dramatic play items were not easily accessible to the children. A discussion was had regarding having these objects accessible to them. Inspector recommends that the operator get in touch with their Quality Assurance Monitor regarding this.	32(1)(b)	May 13, 2022	
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; Comments: A bottle of mouth wash was found under the bathroom sink, which was not locked. 48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (c) supervise an infant while he or she eats or drinks. Comments: Inspector saw an infant drinking out of a bottle while unsupervised. A discussion was had with the operator regarding this. Deficiency is now compliant.	48(4)(c)	May 03, 2022	May 03, 2022

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A discussion was had with the operator regarding updating the Diaper Changing Procedures form that is posted. Inspector recommended that the Diaper Changing Procedures be reviewed and updated.</p> <p>During the inspection, operator was observed being attentive to the children. Operator was communicating with the children by getting down to their level. Inspector observed songs being sung and books being read to the children.</p>
