General Comments							

During the time of the inspection, Inspector observed snack time as well as indoor play and outdoor play. Inspector observed positive interactions between Operator and the child, such as getting on their level to interact with them. Inspector observed the child and the Operator painting together as well as reading a book together.

Recommendation that Operator clarify the phone number of an emergency contact in order to ensure that this information is legible in the child's record. Recommendation that Operator make new copies of the Daily Information Sheet, to ensure that the information indicated on the document is legible.

A copy of the Social Development check form was provided to the Operator in order for these to be renewed.

General Comments

A discussion was had with the Operator regarding extended hour and overnight services. Should Operator choose to offer these services, a Change in Service request must be provided to the Quality Assurance Monitor.

Operator must ensure that a physical check is done on children every 15 minutes when left unsupervised while napping. This physical check must be documented. Recommendation that Operator review section 8.1.2 of the Operator Manual (page 54) regarding this.
