Comments: While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed the paint was chipped and the edges were rough. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the operator that the top of the bench and edges of the bench must be sanded down and painted to ensure the safety of children while one the bench.							

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.

While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor verified:

-Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility

When the Quality Assurance Monitor arrived on site children were playing indoor, not long after children got ready to go play outdoors. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed children playing outdoors.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator regarding children being left in the play area alone while the operator brings children to the bathroom. The Quality Assurance Monitor questioned the operator if children are usually left alone in the play area while the operator brings children to the bathroom. The operator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that not once was the operator told to bring all children to the bathroom while bringing one child. The Quality Assurance Monitor explained to the operator that while the operator was at the bathroom with other children, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed an infant playing with toys that could fit in the child's mouth lifting the risk of choking. The Quality Assurance Monitor also informed the operator that with the music so loud in the play area, the operator could have a hard time hearing if the child was to choke. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed a child getting stuck underneath the table and bench in the play area, while they were left alone in the play area. The Quality Assurance Monitor suggested that the operator puts a plan in place to ensure the security and safety of other children while bringing children to the bathroom.
