A renewal inspection occurred today.

When licensing staff arrived, the educator was prepping for the afternoon. A clear schedule was written on the dry erase board for the day.

Children were observed washing hands before having apple sauce, cheese, and crackers for snack.

Children engaged in free play after snack. Children were observed engaged in art with their educators, playing with lego, creating their own stories, and playing with bouncy balls. Children had "pause" signs in centers where they were able to leave what they had created from the day before. This allows children to pick up where they left off.

Educator was observed supporting children by helping them problem solve and encouraging them to talk to their peers to resolve conflict.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, planning sheets, playground checks, and daily attendance sheets.

A review of all staff and child files were completed.

Discussed with site supervisor about ensuring that children's learning experiences are displayed around the classroom and also documented in the binder that was created for the children to reflect on.

Recommending that site supervisor model communicating with the children, for the new staff in the room.
