<p>General Comments</p> <p>Annual inspection performed. Upon arrival all children were seated at a childrens table eating snack. The Operator provides snack in the AM and PM. A good selection of foods are also provided. Today children had yogurt cups, cheerios and bananas.</p>
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General Comments

The operator provides a relaxed atmosphere during snack and children have lots of time to eat their snack. The children are all under 3 and so the Operator initiates much of the conversation. Lots of discussion about the snack food and the operator encourages the children to repeat after what she says often. Handwashing was observed at appropriate times before and after having their snack and lunches and after coming in from outdoors.

Appropriate child guidance was observed. The operator was observed assisting children with toileting, washing hands and dressing for outdoor play. She engages with the children during activities by asking questions, participating by inviting children into play and introducing them to new vocabulary. She also helps them with clean up and listens and responds to their needs. Documentation of children's learning is also evident throughout the classroom. The operator posts activities on a private FB group so parents are made aware of their daily activities.

The programming room is inviting and lots of activities are provided - Children have been building a web since fall on the 'Seasons' of the year. They have completed fall and winter activities and will be adding to the web this spring. They also worked on a family wall project. Children love to talk about their families and call them by name.

Children were invited into play when the Operator asked them to choose a car or truck to use for painting a rainbow. Children were observed painting and experimenting with different colors of paint to make a rainbow using the wheels of the cars to make different prints. The focus of this week's programming is about Saint Patrick's Day activities.

All children were observed in outdoor play, getting ready and going down for a nap after eating lunch, washing hands and toileting. 4 children nap on cots and one child in a crib at this time.
