### General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the children and Operator were sitting together at the table having apple slices and mini peanut butter and jam sandwiches for morning snack.

The main space was bright and inviting. There was a nice display of children's artwork, and a winter activity learning story posted. Play material was age appropriate and organized in bins and baskets. There was a bookshelf with books available at the children's level and a cubby organized with puzzles. The children were observed playing with a wooden play kitchen and accessories. The Operator was actively engaged with the children pretending to cook and shop for food. Later in the morning the children were observed listening to a story. The Operator read to them using a creative tone of voice and engaged the children by asking them questions about the illustrations. After story time, the children were observed playing at the table with playdough. The Operator was observed asking the children questions about the colours and shapes of the cookie cutters they had chosen as well as what kind of animals they were making.

Transition times were smooth as quick little clean up times were observed before starting a new activity. Throughout the inspection, only positive child guidance was observed. Gentle reminders on sharing and being kind were heard as well as positive words of encouragement and affirmation. Before lunch, the children listened to music and played with musical instruments such as bells, a drum, and shakers.

During the inspection, files were verified, and all required licensing documentation was present. Monthly fire drills are being conducted, and emergency evacuation plans were posted. Children's personal belongings were stored separately in bins and nap matts with blankets were neatly organized.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
