<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct the annual renewal inspection.</p> <p>Upon arrival, children were engaged in free play, including cars, puzzles, the play kitchen, and the playhouse. The operator invited the group to participate in a story, and the children worked together to clean up before gathering to listen.</p> <p>Following the story, children showed interest in musical toys. The operator played music while the children explored various instruments. The group then transitioned into an art activity, where children were given the choice to draw with paint markers or continue with free play. Some children later chose to look at books.</p> <p>Lunch was offered earlier than scheduled to respond to the children's needs, as some were showing signs of tiredness. Children participated in cleaning up while a clean-up song played. During this time, a child asked if they could go on the walking trail after nap time. The operator confirmed, noting that the group regularly spends time outdoors exploring local trails. Due to morning rain, outdoor play was planned for the afternoon.</p> <p>After cleanup, diapers were changed. Infants were seated in highchairs, while older children sat at the table. Lunches were brought from home and served on plates by the educator. Children were actively supervised.</p> <p>Staff and children's files were verified. Fire evacuation drills are conducted monthly.</p> <p>Throughout the inspection, only positive child guidance was demonstrated. Educators provided gentle reminders about sharing and kindness, along with consistent words of encouragement and affirmation.</p> <p>Learning stories and documentation was posted throughout the space.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the license for renewal.</p>
