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General Comments Licensing staff arrived in the morning to do a monitoring visit. The children had just finished having their snack outside, which was provide by the operator and consisted of apple sauce, oranges, cheese, crackers and water. After the children had their snack, they played outside in the fenced in backyard play area. There were large old trees for shade, and the surface was grass and sand in the sand box. They had a variety of ride on trucks and cars, a child playhouse, balls, a sitting bench, a picnic table, and a large sand box filled with a variety of pails, shovels and loose parts. The operator was very engaged with the children and joined them in their games and play. Everyone prepared to walk the walking trail nearby and the operator packed water, hats, attendance forms, the daily information sheets for the infant, first aid kit, cell phone and story books for reading. This activity was a really big hit, and all the children were excited and happy to walk the trail. They watched out for bikes and people walking and understood the rules of safety for this excursion. Everyone enjoyed watching the birds, squirrels and boats in the water and the children talked and told stories. Great discussions were had about why there was a barrier blocking the trail in one direction for the city to do maintenance. The children returned to the home and played outside until lunch time. Everyone went inside to do diaper changes, wash hands and get ready for lunch. Lunch is brought from home, and one little boy was thanking his Mommy for such a good lunch. The children had free play and then went down for their naps. The operator maintains a napping check list with 15-minute checks. In the afternoon after nap time, the children played outside and walked the trail again. Afternoon snack was carrot sticks, apples, berries, granola bars and water. The ELC Home was lovely and cool, clean and organized with many materials inside and outside for the children's play. The diapering and hand-washing signs were posted in the bathroom and the day unfolded pleasantly and enjoyably for everyone.
