Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance observed a child in the staircase. The administrator observed the child and asked a group if the child is intended to be with them or downstairs. The administrator shared that the child was sent upstairs by an educator to go in the upstairs classroom by themselves. The door was closed and the educators from the upstairs room were not notified that the child was coming up the stairs. Preschool children must have direct supervision at all times. The administrator has confirmed that they would do a follow-up with their educators regarding supervision and communication. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the protective surfacing in the infant and preschool play area and the school age play area. Protective surface was observed in the fenced in play area. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a little tyke slide on the grassy area as well as a yellow slide attached to a long black tunnel that did not have a protective surfacing. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the administrator if they have verified if the slides require protective surfacing. The administrator was unable to confirm if protective surfacing was required for the equipment. The administrator has confirmed that they will conduct a verification and will let the Quality Assurance Monitor know of their findings. The equipment should not be used until the operator and or administrator has confirmed that the equipment are installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is onsite for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the outdoor play area and outdoor play material and equipment.
