### General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at Forest Park to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were napping as it was quiet time. The blinds were closed, and soothing music was playing. The transition from quiet time to the afternoon routine was smooth. The Operator opened the blinds and allowed the children to slowly wake up on their own.

The Operator had set up a large tabletop activity once quiet time was finished. This week the children have been interested in frogs and insects. At the table, the Operator set out gems, plastic frogs, grasshoppers, flowers, rocks and blue play dough. The children showed great interest in the activity, laughing together and building different habitats for the insects and frogs. The Operator was engaged in conversation with the children, they discussed which bugs they liked and disliked. A child found two books about frogs and brought them to the table for the Operator to read. Once the children lost interest in the activity, they worked together to clean up before having afternoon snack. Proper hand washing was observed before the children sat together to eat. Cheerios and bananas were given to the children, which reflected what was posted on the menu for today.

The Operator is patient, kind and shows a genuine interest when interacting with the children. Many hugs, back rubs and words of encouragement were heard during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Operator promotes independence and involves the children by offering them child safe knives to cut their own bananas, assisting them if needed. "Look, you did it all by yourself, good job!". The classroom offers natural light through several large windows. Plants, family pictures and current learning stories were posted throughout the rooms. Attendance records were up to date and Fire Drills are being conducted monthly.
