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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at Forest Park Childcare to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, some children were sitting together at a table eating afternoon snack while others were still napping. The indoor environment was bright, organized and welcoming. The children's artwork, family pictures and learning stories were displayed throughout the room.</p> <p>Several bug and insect books along with invitations were prepared and set up for the children to use. After snack time, the Operator sanitized the table before setting out loose parts such as rocks, plastic bugs, wooden disc, gems and homemade maple playdoh. The children were observed making bug fossils with the playdoh and rolling and stacking the playdoh to make bug houses. The children brought two books over to the Operator to read aloud as they built their creations.</p> <p>Later in the afternoon, the children transitioned to the larger room and used pieces of the play couch as gymnastic mats. The Operator followed the needs and interest of the children and allowed form them to engage in gross motor activities, while ensuring they were being safe. The children took turns jumping, rolling and running on the foam pieces. The children freely explored the indoor environment moving between activities such as coloring, stacking bugs and playing tic tac toe. When it was time to go outside for end of the day, the children took turns using the washroom before transitioning outside.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Operator spoke kindly and respectfully to the children. It is evident the Operator follows the interest of the children and builds on it when preparing activities. Child profiles were reviewed today. Files were neatly organized and contained all required documents.</p>
