The cafeteria is set up with interest centres and invitations are present on all tables. Children were observed engaged in a variety of activities throughout the play area. Educators were sitting along side children, supporting play and engaging in conversation.

As discussed at time of inspection, storage shelf is cluttered and disorganized. Some shelves with materials for children require organizing so that materials are displayed to be inviting for children.

Discussed with educators need to ensure attendance records are present with groups when they separate.
