General Comments

Follow up to renewal inspection was completed today. Improvements were noted within the program set up. Shelving containing materials was opened up today for the children to explore. Ensure these storage shelves are tidied and organized at the end of each day. Materials have been added to the environment to support interests and enhance variety. Science related materials, books, and costumes are some of the items that have been added.

As interests continue to evolve, additional props should be added to support these. For example, the children have been enjoying costumes and dress up. Adding props like cash registers, vet kits, clip boards, menus, pretend food and baking sets to the dramatic play area will extend these interests. Also discussed the need for

additional documentation to be posted within the environment. Using poster boards, displaying models made by the children and adding a digital photo frame to display the children's photos are all options to demonstrate learning.

Rakes are now on site to be used to level surfacing prior to children using the stationary equipment. Ensure this is done each day. Supervisor has requested a work order to repair the fabric hazard on the playground, email has been provided to inspector to confirm this. These pieces of equipment should not be used until tripping hazard is removed. QA monitor will follow up on this at next monitoring inspection.
