## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred February 19, 2025.

During the inspection, children were observed engaging in both outdoor and indoor free play. Proper handwashing practices were noted during the transition from outdoor to indoor activities.

Educators reported that children are currently very interested in being active outdoors in the snow, participating in group and individual sports in the gym, drawing, coloring, and forming meaningful relationships with the educators. Positive language and gentle reminders were consistently used by educators throughout the day.

The facility maintains a daily incident log, and parents are informed of any incidents. In cases of reportable incidents, incident report forms are completed. Parents of children present at the center are allowed entry at any time. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and documented. The license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance are posted in a clearly visible and prominent location. Additionally, the daily routine and evacuation procedures are displayed in accessible and noticeable areas.

The facility provides a varied supply of suitable equipment, materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products, including chemical cleaners, are securely locked and inaccessible to children. The changing area is situated within one meter of a sink, and diaper changing procedures are posted and easily visible to those performing diaper changes. Drinking water is available to children throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth, ensuring safety during outdoor play.

The facility offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Children are encouraged to express creativity, explore the arts and sciences, achieve accomplishments, solve problems, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships. A discussion was held with the Administrator regarding maintaining
