Comments: Inspector verified that the Potential Illness Form and Return from Exclusion Form were signed by parent/guardian when a child was sent home due to illness and upon the child's return to care. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
A follow-up inspection was conducted. The Inspector verified that all compliance orders identified during the renewal inspection had been satisfactorily completed. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, the Inspector observed the children finishing lunch while educators were preparing them for their scheduled nap period. Educators reported that, following the adjustment of the children's lunch schedule to 11:00 a.m., children are no longer falling asleep during lunch or while lunch preparations are underway. Staff indicated that all children are now consuming their lunches prior to naptime and are receiving their afternoon snack after waking, rather than eating missed lunch portions. The facility is recommended for license renewal, pending receipt of a recommendation from the Office of the Fire Marshall.
