Comments: Deficiency is now compliant Observed several toxic products (Clorox wipes, draino, vim, bleach, hertel, comet, etc) under both sinks in the kitchen that were only locked with a child lock belonging to the church. Childcare operator promptly had the toxic products properly locked as per licensing regulation before end of inspection.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Only room currently in operation is the main room upstairs.</p> <p>While waiting for the second bus to arrive, children are provided with the opportunity to play outside. When the second bus arrives, everyone goes inside. When inside, children were observed quickly getting their snowsuits off so they could go into the classroom and find out what kind of mischief "Lucky", their Elf of the Shelf, got into last night! Licensing staff learned that the center has special gloves that the children can use to touch Lucky so that she doesn't lose her special Christmas powers.</p> <p>Educator then had a quick circle time with them where children were provided time to share how their way went if they wanted to. After circle time, they were able to play at whichever center they wanted to. Children were quick to pick dramatic play (puppets specifically), drawing, marbles, and a few were observed making a special craft for Lucky the Elf.</p> <p>Educator was observed partaking in all children's activities while inside. He ensured he was constantly moving from each center so that he could actively engage with everyone.</p>
