General Comments

Preschool children were cleaning up from their quiet time activities and getting ready for snack. While the k-2 school age children were given the option to have snack or to play at centers around the room.

Educators were observed sitting down and eating snack with the children. They were also observed actively engaging in conversation with the children, creating a natural home-like environment.

After snack, both groups of children went outside to play for the remainder of the day. When the grade 3-5 children arrived from school, they went directly outside but were also provided the chance to have snack if they wanted to.

All educators were observed being attentive and playing with the children during time of inspection. They were observed providing gentles reminders to the children, when need be, and they were quick to act and comfort children when needed. They were also observed ensuring they got down to the children's level when speaking with them.

During today's monitoring inspection, the preschool indoor environment was observed to contain a wide variety of play materials and documentation that follow the values and beliefs of the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework for Early Learning and Childcare. Some materials observed included wooden bowls, wooden tools, and other natural resources (sticks, twigs, leaves, pumpkins, apples, etc).

Observed plenty of documentation on the walls of the facility of programming ideas and children's work, such as idea webbing that the children participated in, learning stories, and pictures.
